

5 Steps to Obtaining Your Alabama Journeyman Gasfitter's License

Step 1. Sign up for the exam.

To qualify to take the journeyman gasfitter's exam, you must complete a Board-approved apprenticeship program or work for two years as an apprentice. To obtain an application, you may contact:

Exam and License Fees: There is a non-refundable fee of \$100 to take the exam. Candidates who take and pass this exam will have their first year certification fee waived by the Board. The renewal fee for this license is \$30. Licenses expire on December 31.

Step 2. Purchase the required books for your exam.

Step 3. Start studying!

To fully prepare for your exam it is best to thoroughly study the required documents and books, as well as any recommended studying materials. The amount of preparation time

needed will be different for each individual. Be sure to allow yourself enough time to fully prepare for the exam.

Step 4. Follow the rules.

Be sure to bring at least one form of government-issued identification (Driver's license, State ID or Military ID) to the exam. Your identification must have a picture, signature and pre-printed name.

It is imperative that you follow any rules set by the Board and the entity issuing the examination. Refer to those rules in determining what items you may or may not bring with you to the examination site.

Step 5. Good luck on the exam!

It is best that you arrive at the testing facility least 15 minutes before your exam's scheduled start time. You will be given ample time to complete your exam, so be sure to read all directions and questions very carefully. Good luck!
